Clothing, as the weather gets warmer we aim to be outside more and it is helpful to us if all bags, clothes etc. can be clearly named. Could you apply sun cream to your child and bring a sun hat and extra sun cream in their bags please.

It is also really helpful if the children can wear clothes that encourage independence in self-care, sleeves they can roll up and trousers they can pull up and down easily. This is especially important as we work with the children in preparing them for school.



Drop off and collection times

Medicine

If your child has had medicine before coming to Kindergarten it is important we know what it is and when it was given, one of the staff will fill in a form that you will need to sign, thank you.



Lunch boxes, as the weather gets warmer please can you ensure that children have a cool pack in their lunch box. This is a recommendation made by the Environmental Health Officer who visited Kindergarten.
